City zone SSP Sarfraz Nawaz said that a squad of Baghdadi police station arrested Abdul Rehman and recovered two 9mm pistols, bullets and seven snatched mobile phones from him. Rehman was accused of killing Constable Moiz Khurshid in Lyari on May 7. Moiz was posted as driver of SSP City. Moiz was sitting outside his house near Shehzada Manzil Lane II in civvies on the night of May 7, when Rehman and his accomplices came riding down the street snatching cash and mobile phone from the neighbourhood people. Moiz was pulling out his pistol when the muggers saw his action and instantly opened fire on him. Moiz died on the spot while six-year-old Abu Bakr and 18-year-old Jahanzaib were injured in the attack. Meanwhile, sources in police attributed the arrest

in the Lasbela district of Balochistan which borders Karachi. Since Hub was not in Karachi police jurisdiction, and the Baghdadi police did not wanted to miss the target, Kaliya made an illegal raid in Balochistan police jurisdiction and hauled Rehman to Baghdadi police station. Rehman's arrest was however officially declared in a raid at a hideout in Moosa Lane of Lyari. According to SSP City Sarfraz Nawaz, the Baghdadi police conducted an operation near Meeran Peer Graveyard Moosa Lane and arrested Abdul Rehman over charges of the murder of Constable Moiz. A case under sections of terrorism, robbery and murder was lodged at the Baghdadi Police Station. According to SSP East, the arrested suspect is a habitual criminal and was wanted in numerous murder, attempt to murder and robbery crimes.

Freeing up land

Demolition around waterpark

Separately, the apex court ordered the KMC administrator and Karachi commissioner to submit photographs, attached with a report, to show that the Aladdin Water Park has been restored to its original condition. The order read all debris must be removed by June 16 after razing the club and shopping centre structures. The court announced this decision when hearing the case against encroachments and illegal structures near Aladdin Amusement Park. It stated the park was converted into a club and a shopping centre was established inside premises for commercial activities. The court clarified this was not the purpose for which the facility was constructed. According to the verdict, the police department and the paramilitary force would provide assistance to authorities for the demolition operation.

 Dust and thunderstorms and light rain are likely to occur at scattered places in Sindh from June 16 to 19, under the influence of first pre-monsoon rain-spell expected to commence in the province from Wednesday.

According to a warning issued by the Pakistan Meteorological Department's (PMD) Karachi Regional Centre, urban flooding may hit Badin, Thatta, Hyderabad, Umarmkot, Dadu, Sukkur and Larkana districts.

Assistant Meteorologist Zafar Mahmood said that hot spell in central and upper Sindh would subside due to the pre-monsoon showers. Mahmood said in the advisory that thatched huts, roofs made of tin and asbestos sheets and billboards could suffer damage due to strong gales of winds.

Monsoon season, known across South Asia as Sawan, traditionally starts from July 15, however, climate change impact and global warming has changed the eons old rain cycle which now starts a month earlier.

Meanwhile for the port city of Karachi, the meteorologi-

cal department gave forecast of partly cloudy weather with chances of drizzle in the next 24 hours. The minimum and maximum temperatures are expected to remain from 29 to 37 degree centigrade with 70 to 80 per cent humidity in Karachi over the next 24 hours.

Emergency declared

Meanwhile, power utility supplying electricity to southern districts of Sindh has declared rain emergency in view of expected monsoon rains and thunderstorm.

Hyderabad Electric Supply Company (HESCO) CEO Rehan Hameed on Tuesday declared rain emergency and cancelled leaves of all employees to cope with any untoward situation during the rains.

According to HESCO spokesperson, a control room headed by Chief Technical Officer Zahid Parvez Mughal has been set up at HESCO headquarter to receive and resolve complaints of the consumers during emergency.

HESCO CEO Rehan Hameed has directed staff of all sub divisions to remain alert round the clock to face any situation during rains.
